Dear Out of School Club Members,

In these uncertain times we want to clarify what will happen to the Out of School Club in the event that the school is required to close due to COVID-19.

As an OFSTED regulated setting, the club will have to follow the same guidance as the school. Therefore the club would align to any closure period the school announces.

In the event the school is closed but not reopened before Easter it is therefore likely that Holiday Club would not operate. If school had reopened before Easter, any decision to open Holiday Club would of course be subject to staff availability as well as sufficient demand for places.

If the club were to have to temporarily **close**, you will receive credit for all cancelled sessions you have booked & paid for your children during the closure period.
